Message from Luton Borough Council. “Parking on school keep clear (yellow zig-zag) markings endangers other parents and pupils and therefore, the Council is introducing CCTV camera monitoring to enable increased enforcement. CCTV cameras are being introduced to our school before the end of February 2018. If vehicles continue to park on the zig-zag markings the owners are highly likely to be issued a Penalty Charge Notice and a fine of £70. Safety is everyone’s responsibility so please think before you park and park somewhere safe and legal.”
