This is an extract from our school uniform policy: **Appearance**

- No jewellery is allowed other than a watch and a single set of small plain studs which **must** be removed for PE lessons. Children that wear any other jewellery will be asked to remove them.
- Haircuts should be suitable for school – we actively discourage fashion fads including shaved hair designs and dyed hair.
- Shoulder length hair or longer must be tied up at all times with a plain hairband.
- Alice bands may be worn but need to be plain and school colours
- Make up and nail varnish are not appropriate for school.
- Sunglasses are not allowed to be worn by pupils in school.
- Additional accessories and fashion fads, **like** large bows for example must not be worn in school.

On the 26th June in the afternoon we will be completing a full lockdown drill. This is just a rehearsal but we will be completing all of the normal procedures as if it was a real lockdown situation. You may not be able to enter or contact the school during this time. Please see the additional letter that was sent out.

Please do not manoeuvre or park your car in the school car park. This entrance is always very busy with children and their families making their way into or out of the school building. **KEEPING OUR CHILDREN SAFE IS ALL OF OUR RESPONSIBILITY.** Thank you for your cooperation.
